This webinar is a collaboration between <u>Afronomicslaw</u> and the <u>South Centre</u>, Geneva, to mark the 25th anniversary of the South Centre. Both the South Centre and Afronomicslaw share a commitment to discuss the protection and promotion of the development interests of countries of the Global South. The theme of the webinar "Towards Justice in the International Economic Order: Proposals from the South," reflects these shared commitments. In particular, the webinar will focus on selected initiatives proposed by the Global South. An important premise of the webinar presentations will be that the Global South has not a mere spectators in the construction of the global order. Among the issues that the webinar will discuss will be access and a development-oriented approach to the WTO TRIPS Council (including the recent waiver proposal by South Africa and India on TRIPS obligations, and attempts to reframe the ecommerce and IP agenda). It will also reflect on the soon to be launched <u>African</u> <u>Sovereign Debt Justice Network</u>, (AfSDJN), relating to issues of sovereign debt that have become particularly germane in light of the COVID19 pandemic.
